Role Purpose: Reporting to the Harbour Master and vested with the same statutory authority, the Marine Operations Director will be responsible for marine operations that can have an impact on the health and safety of the port and will also play a pivotal role in driving commercial marine traffic and cargo growth opportunities. The MOD will also deputise for the Harbour Master in his absence and take an active role in marine operations meetings, contributing to the wider implementation of the safety management system.

Applicants should preferably hold a Masters Unlimited STCW II/2 certificate of competency or Royal Navy equivalent. In addition, previous pilotage experience and a VTS/103 operator license would be advantageous. A planned programme of training will be given.

In addition, the applicant should possess leadership qualities, demonstrate a flexible approach to an ever-changing environment, actively engage with a diverse range of staff, customer and stakeholders and at all times represent the Port Authority with a high degree of integrity and professionalism.

The successful applicant must provide evidence that they are legally entitled to work and live in the UK.
